






Ask the student "Who is he/she/they?"
Then, "Where does he/she work?"




Dress up the characters like a police officer. Have the student practice saying: "He /She is a police officer." "They are police officers."






Dress up the characters like a teacher. Have the student practice saying:

"They are teachers."







Dress up the characters like a cook. Have the student practice saying: "He /She is a cook." "They are cooks."







Dress up the characters

"They are artists."






Dress up the characters
